




















TOMATOES PLANTS BEING PLANTED BY JEFF AND JEN

Variety		Type	Description
Coyote		Cherry	A yellow jewel-like cherry, that bears 6 to 8 on a branch. Very flavorful. Indeterminate. 75 days.
Black Cherry		Cherry	Dark fruit, sweet and complex. An outstanding and sharp tasting cherry with deep mahogany coloring. Indeterminate. 65 days.
Juliet		Cherry	Red, 1 oz fruit, shaped like grape or elongated plum. Full tomato flavor, high yields. Indeterminate. 60 days.
Large Red Cherry		Cherry	Produces 1 oz cherry size fruit with excellent flavor. Great for salads or snacks. Fruit grow in clusters. Indeterminate. 75 days.
Sungold		Cherry	Golden-orange fruits in large clusters. Great for snacking a week before full maturity, when it becomes very sweet and delicious. Indeterminate. 65 days.
Super Sweet 100		Cherry	Small round 1 oz. cherry tomatoes are deliciously sweet with a high Vitamin C content. Long clusters of fruit. Indeterminate. 65 days.
Black from Tula		Heirloom	Deep, reddish-brown Russian beefsteak. Smooth skin, fairly heat-tolerant. Delicious slightly sweet fruit, 8-12oz. Indeterminate. 78 days.

Variety		Type	Description
Black Krim		Heirloom	Flattened 4-5" globes with dark greenish-black shoulders. Likes hot weather. Rich complex flavor, sweet-tasting fruit. Indeterminate. 75 - 90 days.
Cherokee Purple		Heirloom	Dusky rose, purple fruit, large 10-12 oz, heavy producer. Very popular tomato from Tennessee. Sweet rich flavor. Indeterminate. 80 days.
Costoluto Genovese		Heirloom	Large, deep-red, juicy tomatoes are deeply ribbed but fully flavored and absolutely delicious. This variety is hearty and does well in hot weather. Indeterminate. 78 days.
Flamme		Heirloom	Orange salad tomato. French heirloom. Very juicy with sweet flavor. 2 - 3 oz, very productive and tasty tomato. Indeterminate. 70 days.
Stupice		Heirloom	Compact plants with potato leaf foliage loaded with clusters of 2" fruits. Quite early, great flavor. Heavy yields all season. Indeterminate. 62 days.
Bella Rosa		Hybrid	Heat tolerant and resistant to tomato spotted wilt virus. Expect high yields of large, 10 to 12 oz. delicious tomatoes with bright red flesh. Determinate. 75 days.
Better Boy		Hybrid	Bright red slicers, disease resistant. Good general garden tomato. 12-16 oz. Indeterminate. 75 days

Variety		Type	Description
Celebrity		Hybrid	Red. Hybrid, flavorful, large firm tomatoes, 8-12 oz, strong vines, disease resistant. Good slicing tomato. Determinate. 70 days.
Chef's Choice Bicolor		Hybrid	The beautiful yellow color of the skin hides the internal crimson stripes that make the sliced fruit so attractive. Sweet and savory. Indeterminate. 75 days.
Chef's Choice Black		Hybrid	Large, dark, red-purple 8-12 oz. fruits with green shoulders and a flattened globe shape. Full of flavor. Indeterminate. 75 days.
Chef's Choice Orange		Hybrid	The 5 to 6 inch beefsteak-type fruits have flattened globe shape, averaging 9 to 12 ounces each, with bright orange, almost neon color both inside and out. Indeterminate. 75 days.
Lemon Boy		Hybrid	Yellow, not golden. Vigorous plants produce large harvests of sweet but tangy tomatoes. 8 oz fruit, easy to grow. Indeterminate. 72 days.
