Tomato Shopper's Guide to Success

Preface to Descriptions for the Tomato Varieties

- 1. Tomato Categories:** Listed according to size: "large-to-very large" (0.5-2 pounds), "small-to-medium" (4-8 ounces), cherry (0.5-3 ounces). We listed "paste" tomatoes as a separate category. Observed size (& yield) can vary with growing conditions in the garden.
- 2. Tomato Flavor & Texture:** Flavor is mainly determined by the sugar and acid content. *Sweet:* high sugar and low acid; *Tart:* high acid, low sugar, *Tangy:* both sweet and tart. Aroma-molecules lend *citrusy, fruity* or *smoky* tones. A *well-balanced* flavor refers to a classic tomato taste. The intensity of flavor can be *mild* or *rich*. The texture is determined by water content and can be *meaty* or *juicy*. *Firm* texture indicates that the tomato holds up to slicing.
- 3. Tomato Color:** Color pigments serve as antioxidants and while they do not directly determine flavor, some correlations exist. Red tomatoes are typically well-balanced in flavor, yellow/gold/orange tomatoes are typically sweet, fruity, citrusy in flavor, purple tomatoes are typically smoky and slightly sweet in flavor, green tomatoes are typically tangy, fruity, citrusy in flavor. Bi and multi-color tomatoes can have unique combinations of flavors.
- 4. Growth Habits:** **Indeterminate** plants continue to grow 6-8 ft and produce tomatoes all season. These need large cages or stakes and pruning of suckers. **Determinates** grow to 3-4 ft and need only small cages and no pruning; fruit set is synchronized for a short harvest period. **Semi-Determinates** are somewhere in between-they continue to grow and produce yet plants are smaller and bushier than indeterminates. **Dwarfs** are bred from determinate or indeterminate varieties for normal-sized fruit on smaller, compact (2-3') plants. Small sized plants which can be grown in containers are designated as such.
- 5. Days to Harvest:** Estimated time from transplant to harvest: **Early Season:** <70 days (by May 1st), **Mid-Season** (70-80 days) (by May 15th), **Late Season** (>80 days) (by June 1st). Fruit set is inhibited by daytime highs above 90 °F and nighttime lows above 70 °F, which in Austin occurs early to mid June.
- 6. Performance:** **Hybrids** are often, but not always, more robust and productive than are **Heirlooms**. Heirlooms often, but not always, have superior flavor. **Heat tolerant** varieties were bred to perform well in the South. **Disease-resistant** varieties were bred to perform under growing conditions that promote diseases caused by soil-dwelling microbial pathogens, root knot nematodes or disease-carrying insects. The disease resistance codes used are listed on the following page.
- 7. Seed Saving:** Varieties listed as "**OP**" (Open Pollinated) will produce seeds that carry the exact traits of the parent, where as "**Hybrid**" varieties do not. Heirlooms are a subcategory of OP and are varieties established decades ago in their country of origin.





