Amaranth	Red Spike	Ideal color and form for late-summer and fall arrangements. Gracefully-arched, feathery plumes. When plants are young and leaves are tender, the foliage makes a nice edible green. Annual. Full sun. Height: 36-60". Spread: 12-24".
Anise	Pimpinella anisum	Sweetly aromatic herb grown for its licorice-flavored seeds and feathery foliage. Great for baking, chai/tea blends, and sausage/spice mixes; flowers attract beneficial insects. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-24". Spread: 8-12".
Basil	African Blue	Produces purple-veined leaves with a strong, earthy flavor and a warm, sweet camphor scent. Decorative flowers that attract bees and other pollinators. Good in tea or pesto. Annual. Full sun. Height: 24-36". Spread: 18-24".
Basil	Blue Spice	Fragrant basil with purple stems and narrow green leaves; flavor is classic basil with warm, spicy notes (clove/anise). Excellent in pesto, tomato dishes, and as a pollinator-friendly edible ornamental. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Cardinal	Thai basil with larger leaves. Edible ornamental with showy flowers. Very uniform, upright habit. Purple stems and dark, purple-red flower bracts. Cinnamon/clove flavor with hints of anise. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Chinese Sweet Lemon	Bright lemon-scented basil with a sweet, citrusy flavor. Wonderful in teas, salads, fish, and Thai/Vietnamese dishes; pinch tips often for a bushier plant. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Cinnamon/Mexican	Sweet cinnamon aroma. Tall, fast-growing plants have distinctive violet stems, veining and flower bracts with lavender blooms and 2" long leaves. Beautiful in casual flower bouquets. Use the flowers in any recipe that calls for basil, or to garnish drinks, salads, soups, pasta and desserts. Flavor is of intense basil with a note of mint, anise and cinnamon. Height: 26-30". Annual. Full sun. Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Dolce Fresca	Compact Genovese-type basil bred for strong flavor and improved disease resistance. Dense, tidy plants are great in pots and produce plenty of classic basil leaves for pesto and caprese. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".

Basil	Dwarf Greek	Compact, dome-shaped Greek basil with a spicy-sweet basil flavor packed into 8–14" tidy globes. Decorative, edible plants are great for small spaces, in pots, or used in garden beds. Flavorful leaves make convenient garnishes and are easily pinched from the plant or stem and sprinkled over dishes. Similar plant to Spicy Bush but with smaller leaves and slower to bolt. Annual. Full sun. Height: 8-14". Spread: 10-14".
Basil	Everleaf Emerald Thai Towers	Very slow-bolting, incredibly productive plant with vibrant Thai flavor. Plants are very upright with purple stems and densely packed, dark green leaves with a purple blush. Makes a beautiful, tidy, towering plant. Annual. Full sun. Height: 24-36". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Everleaf Lemon Thai Towers	Very slow-bolting, incredibly productive Thai basil with bright lemon-citrus aroma. Plants are very upright with purple stems and densely packed green leaves—makes a beautiful, tidy, towering plant. Annual. Full sun. Height: 24-36". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Genovese	Classic Italian variety. Authentic flavor and appearance. Tall and relatively slow to bolt with large dark-green leaves about 3" long. Ht. 24-30". Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Holy (Tulsi Kapoor)	Sacred to Hindus. 1 1/2" long green leaves, with purple stems. Known for its use in Hindu culture and Ayurveda. Also known as Tulsi. A common ingredient in Thai cuisine and in teas. Used medicinally for digestion and immune system support. Height: 16–22". Annual. Full sun. Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Holy (Tulsi Krishna)	Sacred to Hindus. 1 1/2" long green leaves, with purple stems. Known for its use in Hindu culture and Ayurveda. Also known as Tulsi. A common ingredient in Thai cuisine and in teas. Used medicinally for digestion and immune system support. Height: 16–22". Annual. Full sun. Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Holy (Tulsi Rama)	Sacred to Hindus. 1 1/2" long green leaves, with purple stems. Known for its use in Hindu culture and Ayurveda. Also known as Tulsi. Basil	Italian Large Leaf	Classic Italian basil with large, tender leaves and sweet, clove-like aroma. A go-to for pesto, caprese, sauces, and sandwiches; harvest regularly to keep plants productive. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Lemon	Citrusy basil with bright lemon fragrance and a clean basil finish. Great for marinades, salads, seafood, and infused water/tea; pinch flowers to extend leaf production. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Licorice	Basil with strong anise/licorice aroma and a slightly spicy finish. Excellent in Thai-inspired dishes, stir-fries, and as a flavorful garnish; also attractive to pollinators when in bloom. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Lime	Has a zesty citrus aroma. Adds a unique flair to cocktails, fish, and salads. Compact plant has 2" long bright-green leaves. Ht. 16-20". Edible Flowers: Use the flowers in any recipe that calls for basil, or to garnish drinks, salads, soups, pasta, and desserts. Flavor is of intense basil and citrus. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Mammolo	Traditional Italian basil prized for strong, sweet Genovese flavor. Productive plants yield tender leaves ideal for pesto, sauces, and fresh use; harvest often for continuous growth. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Mrihani	Heirloom variety of basil stands out boldly from any other. Offers uniquely shaped leaves with dramatic wavy serrations along the edges with a flavor and scent that is much different in comparison to Italian or Thai varieties. It is very bright and perfumed with hints of sweet citrus and anise. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Osmin	Add color and scent to your bouquets with basil. Aromatto has sturdy, purple stems, dark-purple flower bracts, and purple-green bicolor foliage. Spicy flavor. Sweeter-tasting than Genovese basil. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Basil	Siam Queen Thai	Spicy, anise-clove flavor. Attractive purple stems and blooms. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Bee Balm	Panorama	Popular, multi-purpose perennial in shades of lavender, salmon, magenta, and pale to bright pinks. Attracts bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds to the garden. Add petals to salads, sprinkle over mild fish, use in fruit salads, or to garnish desserts and drinks. Flavor is minty and spicy. Full sun. Height: 24-36". Spread: 18-24".

Blue Butterfly Pea Vine		Twining vine with striking deep blue flowers used for natural color in teas, cocktails, and desserts (often shifts purple/pink with citrus). Heat-loving and fast-growing—provide a trellis or support. Tender perennial (grown as annual). Full sun to part shade. Height: 6-10 ft. Spread: 3-6 ft.
Borage		Edible flower with mild cucumber flavor. Large plants bear hundreds of small edible flowers, mostly blue and some pink. Long harvest period. Borage flowers attract bees and butterflies. Annual. Full sun. Height: 24-36". Spread: 18-24".
Calendula	Indian Prince	Clear bright-orange blooms are reminiscent of gerber daisies. Petals of the flowers can be used fresh or dried in "flower confetti," soups, soufflés, rice dishes, baked goods, and to garnish desserts. Calendula is a popular choice for brightening up salad mix. Flavor is tangy and slightly bitter. Annual. Full sun. Height: 12-24". Spread: 12-18".
Catnip		Vigorous, high-yielding plants. Cat-attracting perennial with gray-green leaves and white flowers. Flowers are very attractive to bees Full sun. Height: 24-36". Spread: 24-36".
Cat Grass	Variegated	Fast-growing "cat grass" for nibbling—supports enrichment and helps satisfy chewing instincts. Great for windowsills; keep evenly moist and trim as needed. Annual. Bright light / sun. Height: 6-12". Spread: 6-10".
Chives	Geisha Garlic	Garlic chives with flat, tender leaves and a mild garlic flavor. Great for eggs, potatoes, soups, and herb butter; produces edible white flowers that attract pollinators. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 12-18". Spread: 12-18".
Cumin	Black	Warm-season spice plant grown for aromatic seeds used in tacos, curries, and spice blends. Delicate, ferny foliage and small flowers; harvest seed heads when they dry. Annual. Full sun. Height: 12-18". Spread: 6-10".
Dill	Dukat	Dukat is a bushy, late flowering variety, meaning more leaf production for dill lovers. It is heat tolerant which makes it slow-to-bolt, so you will enjoy fresh picked, aromatic dill throughout the season. Dill is an important host plant for caterpillars of swallowtail butterflies. Annual but can be biennial. Full sun. Height: 24-48". Spread: 12-18".
Dill	Thalia	Slow-bolting dill for bunching and leaf harvest. Uniform habit and blue-green foliage. Wide, flat fronds. Compared to Teddy, Thalia is faster growing and taller (faster to elongate). Teddy stays more

		compact and has a denser leaf form. Annual. Full sun. Height: 24-48". Spread: 12-18".
Echinacea	Paradiso (<i>x hybrida</i>)	Johnny's Vigorous plants with large, purple-petaled flowers. Attracts and is a food source for bees. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 24-48". Spread: 18-24".
Elecampane		Tall medicinal herb with large, soft leaves and bright yellow, daisy-like flowers. Traditionally used in herbal preparations; a dramatic, architectural plant for the back of beds. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 48-72". Spread: 24-36".
Fennel	Grosfruchtizer	It also can be transplanted in January for an April harvest in areas with mild winters. Annual. Full sun. Height: 48-72". Spread: 18-24".
Feverfew		Traditional herb with small, daisy-like white flowers and aromatic foliage. Often grown for pollinators and herbal use; deadhead for longer bloom. Perennial (short-lived). Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Horehound		Hardy medicinal herb with fuzzy gray-green leaves and a bitter, minty aroma. Traditionally used in cough drops/tea; drought-tolerant once established and attractive to bees. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 18-24". Spread: 18-24".
Hyssop		Popular bedding plant and edible flower. Very aromatic with a sweet, licorice-mint flavor. Vigorous plants produce abundant blooms, attracting bees and other pollinators. Leaves and flowers can be used fresh or dried to flavor drinks, salads, soups, pasta, and desserts. Tender perennial. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Lavender	Ellegance Purple	Deep purple flowers bloom the first year on large dense spikes. Plants are bushy, uniform, and well-branched. An alternative to vegetative varieties. Winter hardy in Zones 5-7. Edible Flowers: The flowers can be used to garnish desserts and as a distinct flavor element in baked goods. Flavor is sweet and floral and pairs well with citrus, berries, nuts, mint, and cinnamon. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 10-14". Spread: 10-14".
Lavender	Hidcote Blue	Classic English lavender with deep purple-blue flower spikes and fragrant gray-green foliage. Excellent for sachets, bouquets, and pollinator gardens; shear lightly after bloom. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 18-24". Spread: 18-24".

Lavender	Torch Blue	Showy lavender with vivid purple flower spikes and aromatic foliage. Great for pots, borders, and pollinators; harvest stems for drying. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 18-24". Spread: 18-24".
Lemon Balm	Limoncello	Distinct lemon flavor. Fresh leaves for tea and salads. During the summer, small white flowers full of nectar appear which attract bees. Easy to grow. Mulch if winter goes below 0°F. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 18-30".
Lemon Balm	Mandarina	Distinct lemon flavor. Fresh leaves for tea and salads. During the summer, small white flowers full of nectar appear which attract bees. Easy to grow. Mulch if winter goes below 0°F. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 18-30".
Lemongrass	East Indian	Aromatic grass from India. A delicious addition to soups, curries, teas, and any other dish calling for lemongrass. Essential oil distilled from this variety contains large amounts of citral and geraniol and can be used for flavorings, perfumes, and insect repellent. Tender perennial. Full sun. Height: 36-60". Spread: 24-36".
Lemon Mint (Horsemint)	Native Texas Monarda citriodora	David's Garden Seeds Vigorous blooms add a wildflower look and spicy citrus scent to bouquets. Towers of bright lavender 1 1/2-2" blooms on straight and thin, yet sturdy stems. Also known as lemon bee balm, purple horsemint, and lemon mint. Edible Flowers: Add petals to salads, sprinkle over mild fish, use in fruit salads, or to garnish desserts and drinks. Flavor is minty and spicy. Attracts Beneficial Insects: Nectar plant for bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. Annual. Full to part sun. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Mexican Flame Vine		Fast-growing, twining vine with clusters of vivid orange, daisy-like flowers that draw butterflies and other pollinators. Great on trellises and fences; can be pruned to manage size. Tender perennial vine. Full sun to part shade. Height: 10-20 ft. Spread: 6-10 ft.
Mexican Mint Marigold		Aromatic leaves are a substitute for French Tarragon. Sweet licorice flavor brightens salads and main dishes. The edible, pretty, golden-yellow flowers bloom all summer. Thrives in warmer climates where French tarragon will not grow. Also known as sweet mace or Mexican tarragon. Tender perennial. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 18-24".
Mint	Indian	Cuttings from Su Vonteri. Perennial. Full sun to part shade. Height: 12-24". Spread: 24-36".
Mint	Mountain	A native American species that bears numerous, velvety white flower heads in mid to late summer. Will tolerate dry conditions, and requires little care or maintenance once established. Nectar-rich

		flowers are very attractive to many kinds of beneficial insects. Highly aromatic leaves and flowers are traditionally used in teas, potpourri, and natural repellents. Perennial in zones 5 and higher. Perennial. Full to part sun Full sun to part shade. Height: 12-24". Spread: 24-36".
Mint	Peppermint	Classic peppermint mint with cool, refreshing aroma—great for tea, cocktails, desserts, and savory dishes. Best grown in pots or contained beds since it spreads readily. Perennial. Full sun to part shade. Height: 12-24". Spread: 24-36".
Mint	Spearmint	Classic spearmint mint with cool, refreshing aroma—great for tea, cocktails, desserts, and savory dishes. Best grown in pots or contained beds since it spreads readily. Perennial. Full sun to part shade. Height: 12-24". Spread: 24-36".
Marshmallow		Herb/flower start for the garden. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 36-60". Spread: 24-36".
Nasturtium	Empress of India	Victorian-era heirloom. Scarlet flowers stand out amid the dark blue-green foliage. Compact, mounded plant habit makes it especially suitable for containers or as an edging plant. Edible Flower: Use the flowers as garnishes, or stuff with soft cheese. The flowers can be minced and added to butters and the immature seed heads can be pickled. Nasturtiums are a popular choice for adding color to salad mix. Peppery-flavored foliage is also edible. Annual. Full sun. Height: 10-18". Spread: 24-36".
Nasturtium	Alaska	The vigorous, trailing, variegated foliage is spreading and covered with blooms in a variety of colors. A single spur type, the blossoms are a spicy addition to a salad. Annual. Full sun. Height: 10-18". Spread: 24-36".
Nasturtium	Salmon Baby	Compact, dwarf variety that produces dark green leaves and blooms in varying shades of salmon pink. This petite nasturtium is ideal for containers or the front of flower beds, continuing to bloom from mid-summer to the first frost. Grows to 12". Annual. Full sun. Height: 10-18". Spread: 24-36".
Native Texas Wildflower Mix	Gallon pots	Assorted native Texas wildflowers for extended seasonal color and pollinator support. Mix typically includes a range of bloom times/heights; best in full sun with well-drained soil. Annual/perennial mix. Full sun. Height: 12-36". Spread: Varies.
Nepitella	Calamintha nepeta	Nepitella (calamint) has small, aromatic leaves with a gentle mint/oregano vibe—great in sauces, roasted vegetables, and teas. Airy flowers are loved by pollinators; tidy, mounding habit. Perennial. Full sun to part shade. Height: 12-24". Spread: 18-24".

Oregano	Greek	A true Greek oregano. Strong oregano aroma and flavor; great for pizza and Italian cooking. Attracts beneficial insects such as bees, hoverflies, lacewing larva, parasitic wasps, and tachinid flies. Edible Flowers: The flowers have an oregano flavor and can be used in the same manner as the herb. They are especially good in pasta salads, green salads, and as a fresh pizza topping. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 12-24". Spread: 18-24".
Oregano	Zaatar	An oregano relative with zesty flavor. Native to the Mediterranean, where it has flavored meals for thousands of years. Soft gray-green leaves on plants with a semi-upright habit. Flavor combines those of sweet marjoram, thyme and oregano. Not to be confused with Za'atar, an herbal blend of several ingredients. Tender perennial. Full sun. Height: 12-24". Spread: 18-24".
Parsley	Giant of Italy	The preferred culinary variety. Huge dark green leaves with great flavor. Strong, upright stems make Giant of Italy one of the best parsley varieties for fresh-market sales. Very high-yielding flat-leaf type. Biennial. Full to part sun. Full sun. Height: 12-18". Spread: 10-14".
Rosemary	Officinalis	Although the flowers are small, they have a bold rosemary flavor. They should be used fresh as a garnish for savory dishes and salads, and pair well with roasted vegetables, fruits, or whipped cream. Perennial shrub. Full sun. Height: 24-48". Spread: 24-48".
Sage	Clary	Bold, aromatic clary sage with large textured leaves and showy flower spikes. Great for pollinators and as a dramatic ornamental; leaves are traditionally used in herbal preparations. Biennial (often grown as annual). Full sun. Height: 24-48". Spread: 18-24".
Sage	Common	Wide variety of culinary uses. Dusty green leaves are used in dressing, sauces, salted herbs, sausage, and tea. Makes a good base for dried floral wreaths. Medicinal: Leaves are used as digestive and nerve tonics. Edible Flowers: Lovely small lavender flowers appear in early summer with a mild and sage-like flavor. Flower spikes can be battered and fried, cooked in rice, egg, or cheese dishes, or used to garnish salads and pizza. Perennial in Zones 4-8. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 18-24".
Sage	Extrakta	Robust, uniform plant. Also known as garden sage. Edible flowers: Use as garnish, or as an ingredient in rice, egg, or cheese dishes. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 18-24".
Salvia viridis	Oxford Blue	Versatile garden flower. Easy-to-grow plants for casual cut flowers, pollinator plantings, and displays of color in the garden. Productive, densely branched plants produce abundant stems and multiple cuts

		of this versatile crop. Suitable for fresh or dried flowers. Colored bracts of vibrant deep blue decorate the tops of 30–40" branches. Tolerant of frost. Annual. Sun but tolerates part shade. Height: 18-24". Spread: 12-18".
Shiso	Red	Versatile Asian culinary herb. Used in Asian cooking, sushi and salad mix. Red shiso adds brilliant color to radish pickles and umeboshi plums. Also known as perilla. The flowers are a flavorful addition to salads and Asian dishes. Pairs well with fish, rice, noodles and cucumbers. The minty, basil-like flavor has hints of clove and cumin. Annual. Full sun. Height: 18-30". Spread: 12-18".
Summer Savory		Peppery, thyme-like herb traditionally paired with beans, lentils, and roasted vegetables. Pinch often for a bushier plant and harvest sprigs fresh or for drying. Annual. Full sun. Height: 12-18". Spread: 10-14".
Thyme	Creeping	Sturdy aromatic ground cover. Slender, creeping stems and round leaves with lavender blooms. Can withstand light foot traffic and gives off pleasant aroma when walked upon. Drought tolerant once established. Perennial. Sun to part shade. Perennial. Sun to part shade. Height: 2-4". Spread: 12-18".
Thyme	French	Classic culinary thyme with tiny, intensely aromatic leaves. Essential for soups, roasts, and herb blends; drought-tolerant once established and great for containers. Perennial. Full sun. Height: 8-12". Spread: 12-18".
Thyme	Orange	Classic thyme appearance with a citrus flavor. Try it with fish, vegetable and perhaps even dessert dishes. Tender perennial. Sun to part shade. Height: 8-12". Spread: 12-18".
