Broccoli	Amadeus	Green	59	Medium-size fancy heads are dark blue-green with nice domes and a fine bead. Initial heads are followed by good yields of side shoots. Vigorous medium-large plants.
Broccoli	Batavia	Green	62	Vigorous early broccoli with nutty sweet flavor. Large central heads are followed by multiple side shoots for extended harvests. Strong disease resistance
Broccoli	Belstar	Green	65	Heads are medium green and well-domed with a medium-size bead. Strong, stress-tolerant plants with good side-shoot production.
Broccoli	Bravado	Green	65	tightly beaded, big, blue-green domed heads, followed by abundant crops of delicious side shoots to enjoy over a long extended season. Best of all, strong growing and disease-resistant
Broccoli	Burgundy	Purple	37	sprouting broccoli has beautiful purple buds and purple-green stems. Easy to harvest because of concentrated side-shoot production and tall, strong plants. Slender stems with few leaves
Broccoli	Di Cicco	Green	45	traditional Italian heirloom variety producing small, avg. 3-4", main heads projected well above the foliage followed by a large yield of side-shoot spears. Nonuniform in maturity, resulting in a long harvest period.
Broccoli	Green Magic	Green	57	Excellent heat tolerance. Heads are smooth, well-domed, and very attractive. Extremely uniform in maturity
Broccoli	Kariba	Green	66	Cold tolerant for fall and winter production.
Broccoli	Marathon	Green	68	This late variety is highly tolerant to cold.
Broccoli	Monty	Green	56	has shown excellent tolerance to heat and variable conditions. An attractive broccoli with well-domed bright green heads.
Broccoli	Purple Magic	Purple	62	The well-domed heads are a beautiful deep purple overlaid on a dark green background with vibrant, bright violet stems. Suitable for bunching or crowns. 2024 AAS Winner.
Broccoli	Rapini	Green	45	wonderfully delicate and slightly bitter, peppery broccoli flavor. Budding florets should be harvested just before the flowers open for best flavor.
Cauli	Amazing	White	68	Medium-size plants with domed, solid curds and self-blanching, upright wrapper leaves when well fed. Tolerant to both heat and cold stress.
Cauli	Bishop	White	65	well-wrapped heads, excellent vigor, and wide adaptability
Cauli	Cheddar	Orange	58	Beautiful, early, orange cauliflower holds well in the field. It becomes an even brighter orange when lightly cooked
Cauli	Clementine	Orange	55	Brightest orange cauliflower. Big, sturdy plants produce excellent crops, even under less-than-ideal conditions. The earliest maturing orange variety
Cauli	Flame Star	Orange	62	Pastel orange cauliflower with improved heat tolerance
Cauli	Fujiyama	White	45	Fujiyama was bred to produce high-quality heads in warm weather
Cauli	Lavendar	Purple	70	Attractive bright purple florets. Stems are a beautiful medium-purple in fall. Heads are a much brighter violet-purple than Graffiti and have a slightly larger dome.
Cauli	Puntoverde	Romanesco	78	Strong, rugged plants. Outperforms typical romanesco types under stressful weather conditions.
Cauli	Purple Crush	Purple	75	big domed heads with a beautiful rich purple color and superb mild, nutty, sweet flavor.
Cauli	Purple Moon	Purple	62	Early maturing purple cauliflower. Very attractive medium-dark, purple heads. Performs well in warm weather.
Cauli	Synergy	White	60	Large, sturdy plants produce big, well-domed heads.

Cauli	Vitaverde	Green	71	Big, heavy, green heads mature early on large plants
Cauli	Whitaker	Romanesco	80	Similar to standard green type Romanesco except in color.
Cabbage	Conehead	Green	70	handsome cabbages have a solid, rounded, tightly wrapped base of leaves that taper to a point. Flavor is consistently mild and remarkably sweet.
Cabbage	Copenhagen Market	Green	70	Quick-to-mature cabbage heads are 6"-8" in diameter and 3-4 pounds, tightly wrapped, and perfect for small gardens. Adaptable to a range of climates. Resists splitting
Cabbage	Dynamo	Green	58	Excellent early cabbage. Small, dense, globe shaped, blue-green heads that weigh 2½-3 lbs. Excellent field holding ability. Very heat tolerant. Slow to bolt. AAS Winner!
Cabbage	Early Jersey Wakefield	Green	62	Sweet and flavorful, solid and tightly folded conical heads that resist splitting. Will grow up to 5" at base tapering at the top. 2-3 lbs. Greenish white interior. Heat sensitive.
Cabbage	Golden Acre	Green	64	Early 3-4 lb greenheads on compact plants. 5-7" diameter, round, solid, tight, heads. Sweet spicy flavor with buttery undertones when cooked.
Cabbage	Omero	Red	73	3 lb. heads are a vibrant red and are round to slightly oval. Good, slightly sweet and peppery flavor.
Cabbage	Red Acre	Red	80	Solid heads form early on small, compact plants. Resistant to splitting and cabbage yellows disease. Heads store exceptionally well.
Cabbage	Sweet and Tender	Green	71	Midsize flat heads stand well without splitting. Very tender and sweet with a nice, mild, cabbage flavor.
Cabbage	Emiko	Napa	60	Big, dense, full-sized 12 inch heads with tightly wrapped, blemish-free outer leaves and light green to creamy white interiors. Delicious mild, sweet flavor.
Cabbage	One Kilo	Napa	55	Delicate flavor, a soft texture in between that of lettuce and regular cabbage, and tight heads have a creamy yellow interior.
Cabbage	Purple Express	Napa	75	Deep purple-red. Extremely high level of antioxidants. Tangy-sweet, crunchy flesh. Big, 10 to 12 inches tall, with excellent vigor and disease resistance.
Kale	Dazzling Blue	Blue Green	75	smoky blue lacinato type kale. cold hardy.
Kale	Dwarf Blue Curled	Blue Green	60	Tight curled blue green tender sweet leaves. Holds color even in severe cold. Easy to grow. 12-15" uniform low-growing compact plants. EXTREMELY HARDY
Kale	Purple Moon	Maroon Green	68	beautiful frilled & ruffled, deep purple leaves that are loaded with great flavor & super nutrition. The plants germinate and grow vigorously, and can be harvested over a long, productive season. Purple Moon has a mild and nutty flavor
Kale	Redbor	Red	55	Frilly deep purple-red leaves. Extremely uniform plants. Flavor, color, and curling are enhanced by cold weather.
Kale	Red Russian	Maroon Green	50	18-36"H leaves are deep gray-green with red stems and veins that turn bright purple in cold weather. Leaves are flat, non-curved with deeply cut margins. milder and sweeter than other kale varieties
Kale	Wild Russian Frills	Maroon Green	50	Tender, mild & heirloom kale mix with blue-green frilled leaves.
Kale	Black Magic (Toscana)	Green	65	Well-maintained Toscano (dinosaur) kale with long, narrow, blue-grey leaves.
Chard	Italian Silver Rib	Green	50	wide, crisp, silvery-white midribs and crinkled, shiny green leaves.
Chard	Neon Glow	Mixed	50	Magenta and gold stalks that contrast beautifully with deep green, savoyed leaves.

Collard	Flash		55	Vates type. Very slow to bolt. Repeated harvests of smooth dark green leaves.
Arugula	Italian		30	Fast and easy to grow. Peppery flavor.
Asian	Carlton		35	Very dark green komatsuna with good heat and cold tolerance.
Asian	Rosette Tatsoi		45	Round flat 12-inch rosettes of rich green, teardrop shaped leaves. Tender, succulent leaves have a wonderful mild flavor, sweeter than most other Asian greens
Brussels	Catskill		50	Heirloom, compact, and high-yielding variety known for their large, flavorful sprouts. known for cold hardiness.
Brussels	Dagan		100	Smooth, attractive, and holds very well in the field compared. Medium large sprouts
Brussels	Gladius		100	Early and firm with great field-holding ability. Medium-small sprouts.
Brussels	Hestia		100	heavy yields of solid, crunchy, bright green sprouts. Plants are burst and rot resistant
Brussels	Sylvia		50	Sprouts are medium-large, round, and very dense. Black rot resistance.
